



instruments and many national constitutions. Opponent believes that the death penalty violates these rights. This view is finding increasing acceptance among intergovernmental bodies and in national constitutions and court judgments. But correspondingly, the death penalty is not prohibited by the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights (ICCPR) or any other virtually universal international treaty, there are a number of instruments in force with fewer states parties that do abolish capital punishment. Similarly, international customary law does not prohibit the death penalty at the current time, but custom is rapidly changing towards a position in favour of worldwide abolition.
